- Install solar panels to curb energy costs and put more money back in the classroom
- Expand our Child Development Centers for before and after school childcare and preschool

After being given some information about what we're considering, more than 60% of those surveyed said they would vote 'yes'. So, we are leaning towards officially calling a bond election this June. But before doing that, we would like to provide our community – especially those who did not complete the survey – an opportunity to provide the Board with their thoughts and input.
