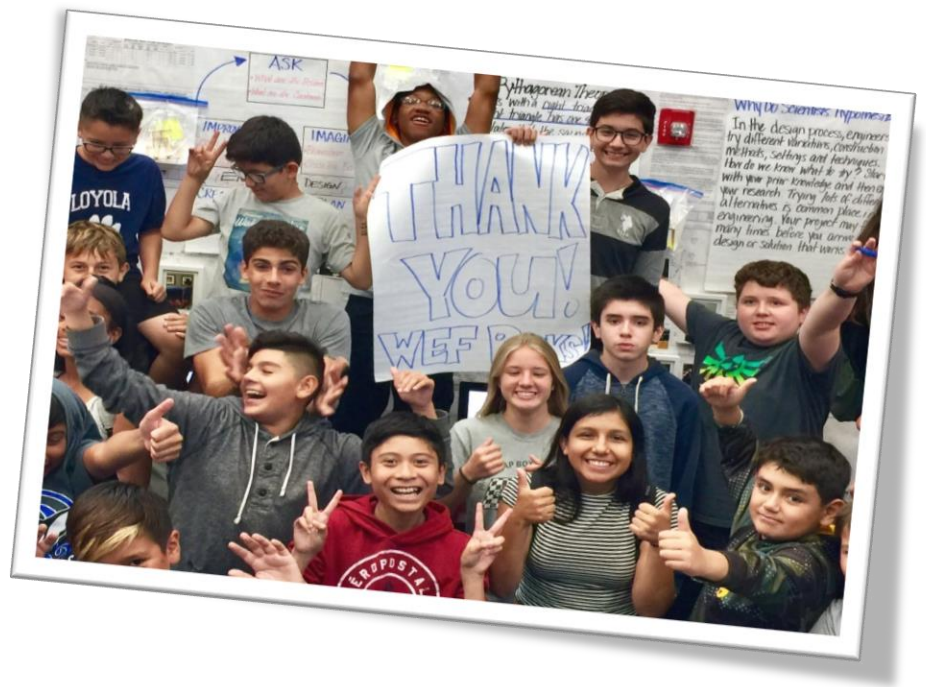
OUR MISSION

Wiseburn-Da Vinci Music Program



Wiseburn Education Foundation enthusiastically granted \$15,000 for the expansion of the Wiseburn-Da Vinci instrumental music program. Funds will be used for the acquisition and maintenance of instruments, fifty Manhasset Music stands, two Manhasset Music stand carts, and music repertoire. Da Vinci Music & Media Pathway, Music Production, and Rock Band students will have access to five Roland HS-5 Session Mixers that will allow the students the opportunity to record, mix and edit content.

Wiseburn Unified and Da Vinci Schools are committed to arts in education, including comprehensive music instruction. From the Harmony Project beginning in grade 2, to the recorder and chorus in grades 3-5, to instrumental music in grades 5-12, to jazz orchestra, rock band, music production, and interdisciplinary media projects in high school, Wiseburn and Da Vinci students have numerous opportunities before, during, and after school to deepen their knowledge, skills, and joy for music.
